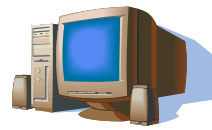

If you would like a copy of instructions mailed to you, please contact the High School office at 319-989-2485.**

## From The Superintendent

WOW! What a beginning to the school year with all of our extra-curricular programs doing very well. We just had 4 students (Ben Bryson, Brett Schwickerath, Lydia Pakala and Rachel Pakala) qualify for the All-State Music Festival which will be held on November 17. Our high school chorus just showcased an outstanding fall concert and several students are preparing to perform in the fall play on November 1<sup>st</sup> at 1 (matinee) and 7 pm, and on the 3<sup>rd</sup> at 7 pm. The girls cross country and volleyball teams are both Conference Champions (this is the first ever conference title for the girls cross country team). The football team just completed an undefeated regular season, winning the District title in exciting fashion in the last game of the season. The boys and girls cross country teams both qualified for the State meet where they placed 8<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> respectfully with freshman John Crew placing 2<sup>nd</sup> overall as an individual. The volleyball and football teams are both well on their way down the tournament trail to potential State Championships.

Other exciting news is that our certified enrollment count is up 22 students, which puts our current enrollment at 846. Over the last two years we have seen a total increase of 49 students to our certified enrollment. This is great news for our district and we are very happy to see our school growing when many others across the State are seeing decreases in their enrollment. Since schools are basically financed by the number of students they serve, this enrollment trend helps to keep us financially sound and allows us to continue to provide good educational programming for our students.

## Dike-New Hartford Board of Education October Board Minutes

The Dike-New Hartford Board of Education met on this date at 7:00 p.m. in the Board Room with Lizer presiding and members Dieken, Hinde, Koop and Nielsen. Also present were administrators Hunt, Laube, Martinek and Textor.

Minutes of the September 17, 2012 regular meeting were approved as written on motion of Nielsen and second of Dieken. Vote all aye.

Dieken moved the Agenda be approved as amended. Second by Hinde. Vote all aye.

Visitors present at the meeting included Kara DeWall, Diane Eilderts, Linda Hensley, Suzanne Perez, and Nicole Kannegieter. On motion of Koop and second of Nielsen, the early graduation requests of Jacob Mobley, Alex Young, Mason Fuller, Jacob Hansen and Brianna Feckers at the end of the first trimester were approved subject to meeting all graduation requirements. Vote all aye.

Hunt reviewed with the board Certified Enrollment numbers for the 2012-13 school year.

Changes to the 500 series policies were reviewed and adopted on motion of Dieken and second of Hinde. Vote all aye.



Koop moved and Nielsen seconded to approve contracts with Cedar Falls and Waterloo Schools for Special Education services provided to Dike-New Hartford students. Vote all aye.

Discussion was held regarding the SIAC Student Achievement Goals for the 2012-13 school year which were approved as presented on motion of Hinde and second of Dieken. Vote all aye.

Hunt updated the Board on recent PLC training for staff members. Nielsen moved and Dieken seconded the proposal to send 28 teachers and administrators to the PLC training in Minneapolis, MN during the summer of 2013. Vote all aye.

Discussion was held regarding computer purchases in the elementary schools and media centers, and network switches and battery backups throughout the district. Nielsen moved and Koop seconded to purchase elementary classroom and media center computers from Apple Computer as per quote. Also, the proposal from Vology for network switches was approved by Koop and seconded by Nielsen. Vote all aye.

Resignations from Angie Dieken as Food Service Director and Part-Time Cook effective October 5, 2012, and Tom Keesy as 2013 Assistant HS Baseball Coach were approved on motion of Koop and second of Nielsen. Vote all aye with Dieken abstaining.

Contract was approved for Jonna Gutknecht as Food Service Director and Part-Time Cook on motion of Hinde second of Dieken. Vote 4-1. On motion of Koop and second of Nielsen, contracts for Tabitha Johnson as Dike Elementary Special Education Associate, Jon Dieken as 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Boys Basketball Coach, Sean Leonard as Head HS Baseball Coach, Randy Dodd as Head JH Wrestling Coach and Tony Norton for AM Weight Room Supervision were approved. Vote all aye with Dieken abstaining.

Hunt reviewed with the Board the upgrades to the landscaping south of the HS Gym entrance. Fire inspection reports were discussed. Nielsen moved and Hinde seconded to begin making the repairs necessary for compliance with the fire marshal standards.

On motion of Dieken and second of Koop the bills of the General, Activity and Nutrition Funds were approved. Vote all aye.

The financial reports of the General, Activity and Nutrition Funds were approved as corrected on motion of Koop and second of Dieken. Vote all aye.

The Board suggested that the school solicit bids for marching band uniforms for future consideration.

The current Early Retirement Policy was reviewed along with a list of employees potentially eligible in 2012-13. No action was taken until after Hunt attends an upcoming conference and reports back with information received.

On motion of Nielsen and second of Koop, approval was given to accept \$108,979.40 from the USDA for repairs relating to the flood of 2008. Vote all aye.

Superintendent Hunt reviewed District Goals with the Board along with progress on Superintendent Priorities and Goal Areas for 2012-13. Also, plans were finalized for the IASB Convention in November.

With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 10:30 p.m.
