

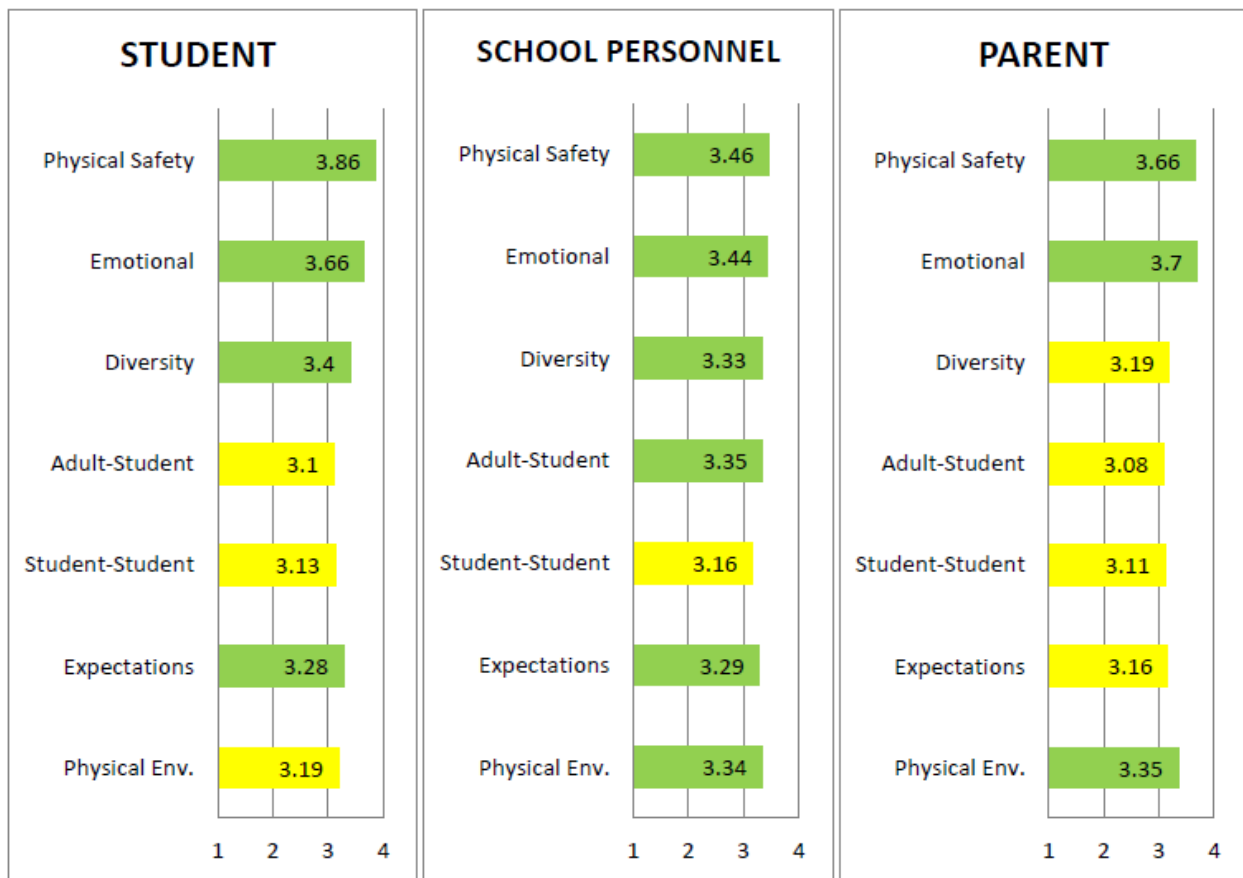
Dike New-Hartford high school students, staff, and parents have many reasons to be proud. The school has received a Safe and Supportive Schools Index of 32 for the second time.

An Index of 32 indicates that our students and our staff are creating a healthy school climate with optimal conditions for learning in the areas of safety, engagement, and environment. There still may be room for improvement.

**Comparing Survey Construct Scores across Students, School Personnel, and Parents**

The following graph shows a one page snapshot of the survey construct weighted means for each population. Weighted means in the green are the best and yellow is second best.

Weighted means in the orange or red indicate a school needs targeted and intensive supports.

A group of staff members and students have worked together to find out why students, staff, and parents responded less positively to the student to student survey statements than other survey statements. They are doing this work as part of applying for Safe School Certification.
