## **KINDERGARTEN HEALTH REQUIREMENTS**

**IMMUNIZATION CERTIFICATE** – Required by Iowa law and must be on file at the start of each school year.

**PHYSICAL EXAMINATION** – Required by Dike-New Hartford School District

Even if your child attended preschool in Dike or New Hartford, a new physical is required for kindergarten.

**DENTAL SCREENING** – Required by Iowa law and must be on file at the start of each school year.

All incoming kindergarten students need to have proof of having a dental screening completed prior to the first day of school. A screening that is done between the ages of 3 to 6 is acceptable. If your child has been to the dentist, take the dental certificate to them to complete.

**VISION SCREENING** – Required for all kindergarten students

**LEAD SCREENING** – Required by Iowa law and must be on file at the start of each school year.

All incoming kindergarten students will need to have a lead screening completed before the first day of school. The screening can be done at any age up to 6 years of age or prior to entering kindergarten if over 6 years of age.
